

Trading Update Q4 2020

Consolidated harvest volumes in Q4 2020 for Salmones Camanchaca were 18,620 ton:

- Atlantic 15,801 tons with average weights of 5.6 Kg wfe
- Coho 2,819 tons with average weights of 4.4 Kg wfe

The total harvest for 2020 were 56,596 tons:

- 52,982 tons of Atlantic with an average weight of 5.4 kg wfe.
- 3,614 tons of Coho with an average weight of 4.3 kg wfe.

Atlantic harvest estimate for 2021 is maintained at 53,000 - 55,000 thousand tons and about 2,000 tons of Coho.

All harvest volumes are provided in whole fish equivalent (WFE)

Salmones Camanchaca S.A. is a vertically and fully integrated salmon producer with operations in farming, processing, marketing and sale of salmonids. The Company harvested 53,000 MT WFE from its core business of Atlantic salmon farming in 2020 and expects to exceed 60,000 MT WFE in 2023. It also began Pacific salmon farming in 2019 and it harvested approximately 4,000 MT WFE in 2019. Overall production of all salmonid species at its own farming sites is expected to reach around 70,000 MT WFE in 2023. The company has approximately 1,800 employees.
