WASTE COMMITMENT



Salmones Camanchaca is aligned to reduce the environmental impact related to the generation of waste, focusing on the development of a value chain that allows strengthening the care of the environment and the relationship with the communities.

For this reason, the Company commits, through its waste management plan, to produce responsibly and properly handle the waste it generates. This plan is based on a hierarchical model that establishes priorities for waste management, focusing on minimizing environmental impact and promoting sustainable practices.

Salmon production is more efficient than other sources of protein, measured by various indices such as carbon footprint and protein retention. A high percentage of the salmon is edible, while the remains are managed to avoid waste, being used as raw materials for other industries. This not only addresses waste management issues but also creates economic opportunities and reduces the sector's vulnerability.

We are aware that proper management of production waste is crucial to minimizing its environmental impact. These organic wastes, originating from our processing plants in San José and Tomé, along with mortalities from the farming centers, are the most significant in Salmones Camanchaca's operation. They are recovered and sent to reduction plants, where they are transformed into other products such as fish meal and oil. This way, they are reintroduced into the system, contributing to a more circular business model.

To monitor the amount of organic waste generated by the company and its differentiation, we have a nutrient recovery indicator, which shows the tons generated annually by type of organic waste.

Among the recovered nutrients in our operations, some are more significant from the perspective of their importance for human consumption, such as protein and omega-3 fatty acids. Therefore, we calculate their volumes based on the total organic waste recovered from our operation, to be used as an indicator of our activity
